QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER REFLECTION:

- 1. What was your home like growing up? Did you experience a home where biblical roles were expressed?
- 2. Husbands, how can you better understand and honor your wives?

D) Pray together that your marriage will accurately reflect the Gospel to your children and the world around you.
