QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER DISCUSSION:

1. Read Titus 1:10-16.

- 2. Paul tells us that one of the primary responsibilities of church leaders is to be on the lookout for false teachers and false doctrine. Why do you think Paul warns so strongly about false teachers?
- 3. What comes to your mind when you think about false teaching and why? Think of some false ideologies that are prevalent today. What is true about each one? How does it distort the truth to become false?
- 4. Matt talked about how none of us are immune from the effect of false teaching. In fact, we sin because we believe lies (false teaching) and act accordingly. How have you seen this in your own life?
- 5. Titus 1:15-16 tells us that what we believe determines how we live and who we are. We will be known by the fruit we bear, but we do not effectively change by modifying our behavior. Instead we have to address our false beliefs and order our lives accordingly. Have someone read Romans 12:1-2. According to these verses, how does transformation occur? How can we experience this "renewing of the mind"?
