## QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER DISCUSSION:

1. Sunday we saw some of what we can expect in our lives as we follow Jesus as our King. What are some attributes of Christ's character that make it easier to trust and submit to Him as King?
  
2. Read Luke 10:1-16. Like the seventy-two disciples, as followers of Jesus we have been commissioned (sent out) to tell others of what Jesus has done in our lives. What has your experience been with sharing what God has done in your life with other people? Who is someone in your life that needs to hear about God's peace? Do you feel equipped for this task? How can your group help you grow in this area?
  
3. Matt taught that being a follower of Jesus means that we carry His character. List a few attributes of Jesus' character that you discussed earlier. Now describe how you think our culture views Christians. How can you grow in carrying the character of Jesus in your own life?
  
4. Although we carry Jesus' message of peace along with His character, the world will largely reject us. Have you experienced rejection as a result of your allegiance to Christ? How does Luke 10:16 encourage us in rejection and guard us in success?
