## QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER DISCUSSION:

- 1. Check in with others in your group. Have each person share a highlight and a challenge from the past week.
- 2. In **Luke 24:52**, we see the disciples full of Joy in an uncertain season. What is something in your life right now that is threatening to steal your joy?
- Our passage this week reminds us about the reality of Jesus' resurrection, the sufficiency of His Word, and the power of the Holy Spirit that lives in us. Which of these three realities is most needed in your life right now? Explain your answer.
- 4. **Luke 24:47-53** stresses the responsibility of Jesus' followers to proclaim the message of the Gospel where they are. Share with your group A) who it was who proclaimed the Gospel to you, and B) who in your life may need to hear the message of Jesus.
