ON TV: What must a person believe in order to be a faithful follower of Jesus?

ON TV: #1: Jesus is **God's Son**, and **our King**.

- **#2:** Jesus came to **reveal** what God is like.
- **#3:** Jesus defines sin as anything that harms you or another person.
- #4: Jesus promised justice in the end and invites us to trust him in the meantime.
- **#5:** Jesus died for your sin to reconcile you to God.
- **#6:** The local church is God's agent of transformation personally, culturally, and globally.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "16 Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. 17a When they saw him..." Matthew 28:16-17a

ON TV: Do you know what they did **next**?

ON TV/OUTLINE: "When they saw him, they worshiped him ... " Matthew 28:17a

ON TV/OUTLINE: "...but some *doubted*." Matthew 28:17b

ON TV: Why would some of them to **doubt**?

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Then Jesus came to them and said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me." Matthew 28:18

ON TV: Do you know why the church and church leaders and Christians have been able to **use the Bible** for all kinds of harmful things that end up hurting people over many years?

ON TV: Jesus is our **ultimate** and **final authority**.

ON TV/**OUTLINE**: "When they saw him, they worshiped him..." Matthew 28:17a

ON TV/OUTLINE: "19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Matthew 28:19-20
