Working Smart – Part 4

SKILL/HABIT #4: TIMING.

“There is a right time and a right way to do everything, but we know so little!” Ecclesiastes 8:6

“Run hard and fast in the faith!” 1 Timothy 6:12

“24 Run in such a way as to get the prize. 26 I Run straight to the goal with purpose in every step.” 1 Corinthians 9:24, 26

“I run to win...” Philippians 3:12

WHEN TO MOVE FAST

1. When God **TELLS** me to do something.

KEY OBSERVATION #1: Delayed obedience is DISOBEDIENCE.

“Jesus said to them, ‘Come follow me...’ So, Simon and Andrew immediately left their nets and followed him.” Mark 1:17-18

“Without delay I hurry to obey your command.” Psalm 119:60

2. When I need to ask or offer **FORGIVENESS.**

“23 If you are giving an offering at worship and you suddenly remember that someone has something against you, 24 leave your offering and go immediately to that person and be reconciled. Then you can come back to worship and offer your gift.” Matthew 5:23-24

3. When I feel **TEMPTED.**

“Run away from all evil things...” 1 Timothy 6:11a

“Run away from the worship of idols...” 1 Corinthians 10:14

4. When I’ve made a **PROMISE** to God.

“When you make a promise to God, keep it as quickly as possible. He isn’t happy with foolish people. Do what you promised to do!” Ecclesiastes 5:4

5. When I have an opportunity to do **GOOD.**

“Do not withhold good from those who deserve it, while it is in your power to act!” Proverbs 3:27

“If you wait for perfect conditions, you will never get anything done.” Ecclesiastes 11:4

“All of us must quickly carry out the tasks assigned us by the Father who sent me, because there is little time left before the night falls and all work comes to an end.” John 9:4

6. When God offers me **SALVATION.**

“God is ready to help you right now! Today is the day of salvation!” 2 Corinthians 6:2b

WHEN TO MOVE SLOW

“2 ...There’s a time to plant and a time to harvest. 4 ...There’s a time to weep and a time to rejoice.” Ecclesiastes 3:2b, 4b

“It’s smart to be patient.” Proverbs 14:29a

1. When I don’t have the **FACTS.**

“The human mind is the most deceitful of all things! It is incurable. No one can understand how deceitful it really is!” Jeremiah 17:9

“Zeal without knowledge is not good; a person who moves too quickly may go the wrong way.” Proverbs 19:2

“To decide before knowing the facts is shameful and stupid.” Proverbs 18:13

2. When I’m HURT or ANGRY.

“Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.” James 1:19b

“Whoever is slow to anger has great understanding, but he who is quick-tempered makes foolish mistakes.” Proverbs 14:29

“The godly think before speaking.” Proverbs 15:28

“Losing your temper causes trouble but staying calm settles arguments.” Proverbs 15:18

3. When making a major DECISION.

“Wicked people bluff their way through life, but God’s people think before they take a step.” Proverbs 21:29

“Ponder the path of your feet; then all your ways will be sure.” Proverbs 4:26

“Sensible people will see trouble coming and avoid it, but an unthinking person will walk right into it and regret it later.” Proverbs 22:3

“Plan carefully and you will have plenty; if you act too quickly you will never have enough.” Proverbs 21:5

4. WHEN WAITING FOR A SEED TO GROW

KEY OBSERVATION #2: Not only will you sow what you reap, and you will actually reap **MORE** than you sow.

“1 There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven... 5 A time to plant and a time to harvest...a time to scatter and a time to gather...” Ecclesiastes 3:1,5

“Keep on sowing your seed, for you never know which ones will grow — perhaps they all will!” Ecclesiastes 11:6
