ON TV: If you don't always feel God's presence, you are not alone.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "13 But I cry to you for help, O Lord; in the morning, my prayer comes before you. 14 Why, O Lord, do you reject me and hide your face from me?" Psalm 88:13-14

ON TV: "Even, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me..." Psalm 23:4

ON TV: "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" Matthew 27:46

ON TV/OUTLINE: Maybe we don't feel God because we're over **HYPING** it.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "30 They asked Jesus, 'What miraculous sign then will you give that we may see it and believe in you? 31 Our ancestors ate the manna in the desert; as it is written: 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.'" John 6:30-31

ON TV: Feeling are not evidence of the presence of God. Feelings are not the only evidence that God is with us.

ON TV: "Without faith, it is impossible to please God..." Hebrews 11:6

ON TV/OUTLINE: We may not feel God because maybe our **HEART HAS HARDENED**.

ON TV/OUTLINED: "14 You'll be ever hearing, but never understanding; you will be ever seeing, but never perceiving. 15 For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes." Matthew 13:14-15

ON TV: Sin in our life separates us from God.

ON TV: Sin breaks the intimacy we have with God

ON TV/OUTLINE: "10 Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. 12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me." Psalm 51:10, 12

ON TV/OUTLINE: Maybe we don't feel God and He is using that feeling to DRAW US CLOSER to Him.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "From one man God made all the nations that they should inhabit the whole earth. He marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands. God did that so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us." Acts 17:26

ON TV: Deprivation draws out desire.

ON TV: Familiarity breeds **contempt**. Absence makes the heart grow **fonder**.
