ON TV: Text Graphic 1 (Y u no text?)

ON TV: Text Graphic 2 (should I get Pizza)

ON TV: Text Graphic 3 (How do you keep an idiot in suspense?)

ON TV: Text Graphic 4 (Hey sorry I was busy)

ON TVOUTLINE: Left on Read

ON TV/OUTLINE: "My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?" Psalm 22:1,

ON TV: Hey God... Why?"

ON TV/OUTLINE: "All who see me mock me; they make mouths at me; they wag their heads;" *Psalm 22:7*

ON TV/OUTLINE: I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint; Psalm 22:14

ON TV: "God...Why?"

ON TV/OUTLINE: It's okay to ask God the <u>hard questions</u>.

ON TV: you're not disrespecting God when you ask Him why, you're allowing him to answer.

ON TV/**OUTLINE**:, "we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance" *Romans 5:3*

ON TV/OUTLINE: And when the sixth hour^w had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour.^w And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, "Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?" which means, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" Mark 15:33-34

ON TV/OUTLINE: And they were not able in the presence of the people to catch him in what he said, but **marveling** at his answer they became silent. Luke 20:26

ON TV/<mark>OUTLINE</mark>: They are not <u>challenging</u> YOU. They are <u>challenging</u> God.

ON TV/OUTLINE: Psalm 22 contains <u>33</u> different details specific to <u>Jesus on the cross</u>.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "All who see me mock me; they make mouths at me; they wag their heads;" *Psalm 22:7*

ON TV/OUTLINE: "...let the LORD rescue him." psalm 22:8

ON TV/OUTLINE: They divide my clothes among them and cast lots for my garment. Psalm 22:18

ON TV: God wasn't leaving mankind on "read." He was waiting to reply once and for all

ON TV/OUTLINE: Jesus didn't just <u>reply</u> to the text message, he <u>became</u> the text message.

ON TV/OUTLINE: You think God's plan is <u>ignoring</u> you, when God's plan is <u>restoring</u> you.

ON TV/OUTLINE: The answer for you isn't something you can <u>answer yourself</u>.

ON TV: the answer isn't materialistic, mystic, or individualistic.

ON TV/OUTLINE: The real answer is <u>simplistic.</u>

ON TV/OUTLINE: And when the centurion, who stood facing him, saw that in this way he^{III} breathed his last, he said, "Truly this man was the Son^{III} of God!" Mark 15:39
