ON TV: Unread: It's all in the Text

ON TV/OUTLINE: Mixed Messages

ON TV/OUTLINE: People understand a text message correctly only 50% of the time.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." Jeremiah 29:11

ON TV: Everybody desires to hear from God.

ON TV/OUTLINE: we all <u>desire</u> to hear from God, but we hope God tells us our desires "

ON TV/OUTLINE: ⁴ This is what the LORD Almighty, the God of Israel, says to all those I carried into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon: ⁵ "Build houses and settle down; plant gardens and eat what they produce. ⁶ Marry and have sons and daughters; find wives for your sons and give your daughters in marriage, so that they too may have sons and daughters. Increase in number there; do not decrease. ⁷ Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the LORD for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper." ⁸ Yes, this is what the LORD Almighty, the God of Israel, says: "Do not let the prophets and diviners among you deceive you. Do not listen to the dreams you encourage them to have. ⁹ They are prophesying lies to you in my name. I have not sent them," declares the LORD.

ON TV/OUTLINE: 4 to all those I carried into exile...

ON TV: Here's how to read God's text a little clearer: Look at the last text from God

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Build houses and settle down; plant gardens and eat what they produce. *Jeremiah* 29:5

ON TV: Plant gardens in a place you don't want to be.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Build and plant"

ON TV: Stay in the Gray!

ON TV/OUTLINE: Romans 12:12, "Rejoice in Hope, Be patient in tribulation, be consistent in prayer."

ON TV/OUTLINE: Tribulation is a fancy word for great troubling

ON TV/OUTLINE: "seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the *LORD* for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper." Jeremiah 29:7

ON TV/OUTLINE: Be committed to the <u>community</u>.

ON TV: If you're willing to plant a garden in a place you don't want to be, you'll see fruit you never thought you'd see.

ON TV/OUTLINE: 8 Yes, this is what the LORD Almighty, the God of Israel, says: "Do not let the prophets and diviners among you deceive you. Do not listen to the dreams you encourage them to have. 9 They are prophesying lies to you in my name. I have not sent them," declares the LORD. Jeremiah 29: 8-9

ON TV/OUTLINE: Make sure it's not the wrong number.
