Character Counts - Part 4 of 4

Your job is essential to God's purpose for you because:

- #1: Your job is where you learn to **DEVELOP** & **USE** the talents, He gave you.
- #2: Your job is where you learn to **HONOR** God by giving him your **BEST**.
- #3: Your job is where you learn to <u>LIVE OUT</u> what you say you believe about God and your love for Him. In reality it's your <u>MISSION</u> field.
- #4: God uses your job to grow your character into spiritual MATURITY.

"From the very beginning, God decided that those who came to Him should become like His Son." Romans 8:29

"...real maturity is that measure of development which is meant by 'the fullness of Christ.'" Ephesians 4:13

How God uses my work to grow my character:

KEY TRUTH #1: God uses **PRESSURE** to teach me **RESPONSIBILITY**

"Live life, then, with a due sense of responsibility, not as people who do not know the meaning of life, but as those who do." Ephesians 5:15

Ways to develop responsibility:

#1: By keeping my **PROMISES**

"(God blesses the one) ...who always does what he promises, no matter how much it may cost." Psalms 15:4

#2: By meeting **DEADLINES**

"One who is slack in his work is a brother to the one who destroys." Proverbs 18:9

#3: By working without **SUPERVISION**

"Don't work hard only when your master is watching...work hard all the time, as though working for Christ." Ephesians 6:6-7

"Unless you are faithful in small matters, you won't be faithful in large ones. If you cheat even a little, you won't be honest with greater responsibilities." Luke 16:10

#4: By controlling **COSTS**

"11 If you are untrustworthy about worldly wealth who will trust you with the true riches of Heaven? 12 And if you are not faithful with other people's money, why should you be entrusted with money of our own?" Luke 16:11-12

KEY TRUTH #2: God uses **PROBLEMS** to teach me **CHARACTER**

"3 We can rejoice when we run into problems and trials, for we know they are good for us - they help us learn to be patient. 4 And patience develops strength of character..." Romans 5:3-4
