## RESPONDING TO GOD Jonah – Part 2

**ON TV:** There's a little bit of Jonah in all of us.

**ON TV/OUTLINE:** "1 The word of the Lord came to Jonah son of Amittai: 2 'Go to the great city of Nineveh and *preach against it, because its wickedness has come up before me.*" Jonah 1:1-2

**ON TV:** Delayed obedience is really **disobedience**.

**ON TV**/**OUTLINE** "But the *Lord provided* a great fish to swallow Jonah and Jonah was inside the fish three days and three nights." Jonah 1:17

**ON TV:** Jonah's worst nightmare as exactly what he **needed**.

**ON TV:** The book isn't about Jonah. He's the best supporting actor. The book is really about **God**.

**ON TV:** The book of Jonah is about a great and gracious God.

**ON TV:** "God save me! I know there's two possible ways to get out of a fish this size. Have mercy on me and let me get out the north end instead of the sound end of this fish. God, please save me.!"

**ON TV**/**OUTLINE**: "1 From inside the fish, Jonah prayed to the Lord his God. 2 In my distress, I called on the Lord, and *He answered me*." Jonah 2:1-2a

**ON TV:** We can call on God and He will answer, even when we've run away or have drifted from Him.

**ON TV/OUTLINE:** "So let us come **boldly to the throne of our gracious God**. There we will receive his **mercy**, and we will find **grace** to help us when we need it most." Hebrews 4:16

**ON TV**/**OUTLINE**: "...From the depths of the grave I called for help, and you listened to my cry." Jonah 2:2b

**ON TV: Sheol** = Grave or Hell

**ON TV:** "I was as good as dead, but God in His mercy, used pain, to allow me to be born again."

**ON TV:** "I couldn't contribute a thing, but I was not hopeless..."

**ON TV:** In spite of what we're facing, we can be **born again**!

**ON TV:** God still did a **miracle**. God was actively working, even though Jonah was **still in pain**.

**ON TV:** 

- Phase 1: God allows a storm.
- Phase 2: God sends the captain.
- Phase 3: The sailors have mercy on him.
- Phase 4: God sends a fish.
- Phase 5: The fish gets a tummy ache and throws him up on shore.

**ON TV:** Never forget the *"But God"* moments.

**ON TV/OUTLINE:** "When my life was ebbing away, *I remembered you*, O Lord, and my prayer rose to your Holy Temple." Jonah 2:7

**ON TV**/**OUTLINE**: "Those who cling to worthless idols forfeit the grace that could be theirs." Jonah 2:8

**ON TV:** Hessed = The **pursuing love** of God.

**ON TV:** First, he had the idol of **prejudice**.

**ON TV:** Second, he had the idol of **self**.

**ON TV/OUTLINE:** "What I have vowed, I will make good." Jonah 2:9b

**ON TV**/**OUTLINE**: "Salvation comes from the Lord." Jonah 2:9c

**ON TV/OUTLINE:** "For it is by the grace of God that you are saved----and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God." Ephesians 2:8

**ON TV**/**OUTLINE**: "And the Lord commanded the fish, and it *vomited* Jonah onto dry land." Jonah 2:10

**ON TV/OUTLINE:** First, whether we are on top of the world, or whether we are in the depths of what feels like Hell, when we call on God, He will answer us.

**ON TV:** "My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me." Psalm 63:8

**ON TV/OUTLINE:** Second, when we respond rightly to God's correction, our way of seeing things changes.

**ON TV/OUTLINE**: Finally, as a result of God's correction, we find ourselves sitting in a place we've never been before.

## **ON TV:**

- First, I want to invite you to release something in prayer that you've been holding onto, but know you need to let it go.
- Second, for those who don't have a relationship with Jesus Christ, let that open hand be the moment where you willingly embrace and invite Christ to be your savior.
- Third, for some of us that have drifted from our faith, see your open hand today as reaffirming your commitment to Christ; that you will begin to again, or continue to cling to him.
