KEY TRUTH #1: Jesus came to establish a **BRAND-NEW** arrangement for every person to be able to **KNOW** God personally.

“But the chief priests and the Pharisees had given orders that anyone who found out where Jesus was should report it so that they might arrest Him.” John 11:57

“19 ‘This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me. 20 In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, ‘This cup is the new covenant....’” Luke 22:19b-20a

“31 ‘The time is coming,’ declares the Lord, ‘when I will make a new covenant with the people of Israel and with the people of Judah. 32 It will not be like the covenant I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt... 33 ...I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts....’” Jeremiah 31:31-33

KEY TRUTH #2: In the first century there were basically **THREE** kind of covenants.

- Between **TWO EQUALS**
- **BILATERAL**: King would dictate terms and conditions to a **LESSER** power
- **PROMISSORY**: One party **BINDS** itself to an obligation for the **BENEFIT** of the other party

BIG QUESTION: What **KIND** of covenant is it?
