

Crazy Faith – Seeing the Breakthrough in Life

Points and Presenter Guide

ON TV: Crazy Faith: Thoughts or actions that lack reason but trusting fully in what you cannot explicitly prove

ON TV: FLUMP- noun: **flump**; plural noun: **flumps**

ON TV: Flump: the action of a **heavy fall!**

On TV/OUTLINE: ² Simon Peter, Thomas (called the Twin), Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples were together. ³ Simon Peter said to them, “I am going fishing.” They said to him, “We will go with you.” They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. John 21:2-3 (ESV)

ON TV/OUTLINE: ⁴ Just as day was breaking, Jesus stood on the shore; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. ⁵ Jesus said to them, “Children, do you have any fish?” They answered him, “No.” ⁶ He said to them, “Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some.” So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in, because of the quantity of fish. ⁷ That disciple whom Jesus loved therefore said to Peter, “It is the Lord!” When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his outer garment, for he was stripped for work, and threw himself into the sea. ⁸ The other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, but about a hundred yards^[a] off. John 21:4-8 (ESV)

ON TV/OUTLINE: Faith HAS to involve Jesus otherwise it isn't faith.

ON TV/OUTLINE: “so that your faith might not rest in the wisdom of men^[a] but in the power of God.” 1Corinthians 2:5 (ESV)

ON TV/OUTLINE: “For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice.” James 3:16 (ESV)

ON TV/OUTLINE: There's FAITH and then there's FAUX FAITH.

ON TV/OUTLINE: “Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith” Hebrews 12:2 (NIV)

ON TV/OUTLINE: Crazy Faith doesn't require your clarity. It requires your obedience.

ON TV/OUTLINE: Jesus is the Perfector of your faith. Not the good luck-er of your faith.

ON TV: The sins of yesterday do not dictate your faith of today.

ON TV/OUTLINE: “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God” Ephesians 2:8 (ESV)
