ON TV: Don't lie.

ON TV: Respect

ON TV/OUTLINE: "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." John 13:34

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Love is patient." 1 Corinthians 13:4a

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Love is patient, love is kind..." 1 Corinthians 13:4a

ON TV: Unkindness is weakness. Unkindness demonstrates a lack of self-control.

ON TV: Unkindness demonstrates a lack of self-awareness.

ON TV: Kindness is choosing to **loan someone your strength** rather than reminding them of their weakness.

ON TV: Never announce a punishment ahead of time to your children.

ON TV: What are you going to **do**?

ON TV: Side with your children before you discipline them.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "... While we were still sinners... Christ died for us." Romans 5:8b

ON TV: What is your go-to response to a weakness in your children?

ON TV/OUTLINE: "It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud." 1 Corinthians 13:4b

ON TV: If you don't feel good about yourself, it is hard to let others feel good about themselves.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "...Love does not dishonor others." 1 Corinthians 13:5a

ON TV: Honor is superior to obedience.

ON TV: What is the **least** I can do **without** getting into trouble and without suffering any **consequences**?

ON TV: Obedience is never at the **heart** of a mutually satisfying relationship, but **honor always is**.

ON TV: Because honor demands that we put someone else **ahead of ourself**.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Be devoted to one another *in* brotherly *love*. Honor one another *above* yourselves." Romans 12:10

ON TV: A healthy marriage is always characterized by **mutual submission**.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ." Ephesians 5:21

ON TV: Dishonesty, disrespect, and disobedience

ON TV: Ignoring it rewards it. And what's rewarded is repeated.

ON TV: "A child who has not been disciplined with love by his little world will be disciplined without love by the great big world." –Zig Ziglar

ON TV: The discipline must directly address the fact that a relationship has been damaged.

ON TV: When we discipline our children, what should we be trying to accomplish?

ON TV: They have **no goal** in their discipline.

ON TV: Discipline makes a person better.

ON TV: The goal of discipline is the restoration of the relationship.

ON TV: Discipline your children in the direction of relationship restoration.

ON TV: At the heart of every wrongdoing is a **fractured** relationship.
