ON TV: Did Jesus make it **clear**?

ON TV: What must a person believe in order to be a faithful follower of Jesus?

ON TV: What are **the basic** essentials and what's not?

ON TV: How do we know what the basics or the essentials are?

ON TV: When cultural and peripheral are considered basic and essential, **Christianity eventually**, is no longer "good news of great joy" for all people.

ON TV: #1: Jesus is God's Son, and our King.

ON TV: #2: Jesus came to **reveal** what God is like.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "35 One of them an expert in the law, tested him with this question: 36 'Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?' 37 Jesus replied, 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Matthew 22:35-40

ON TV: Love for God is **demonstrated and proved** by our **love for others**.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "23 One Sabbath Jesus was going through grain fields, and as his disciples walked along, they began to pick some heads of grain. 24 The Pharisees said to him, 'Look, why are they doing what is unlawful on the Sabath?' 27 Then Jesus said to them, 'The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath.'" Mark 2:23-24, 27

ON TV: People are the priority, not the rules.

ON TV: If someone applies the law of God in a way that **harms people**, they aren't applying it correctly, because the laws are for the **benefit of the people**.

ON TV/**OUTLINE**: "Jesus, is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any and every reason?" Matthew 19:3

ON TV: Because this is the question you ask when you are more concerned about a view than a 'you.'

ON TV: "Pastor, does the Bible say that ______ is a sin?"

ON TV: "If I do is God going to be mad at me?"

ON TV: If the Bible doesn't **condemn it**, well then, God must **allow it**.

ON TV: What's good for people is what's good, and what's not, is not.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You give a tenth of your spices...But you have neglected the more important matters of the law--justice, mercy, and faithfulness..." Matthew 23:23a

ON TV: According to Jesus, what made a sin, a sin, and what does it look like for us?

ON TV:

First: It it's **not good for another person, or you**, it's a sin. **Second:** If it's not good for them or you, **it should be condemned**.

- **ON TV:** Because what God values most is not his rules. What God values most are people.
- **ON TV:** Because He's **for you**, and the **people** around you.
- **ON TV:** When you sin, you break God's law.
- **ON TV:** When you sin, you break yourself and others, which breaks God's heart.
- **ON TV:** Every sin comes with a pre-packaged **consequence**.
