ON TV: Pride

ON TV: "Unchastity, anger, greed, drunkenness are mere flight bites in comparison to pride, because pride leads to every other vice." C. S. Lewis, Mere Christianity

ON TV: #1: Pride diminishes us.

ON TV: Pride diminishes our capacity to admit what we need to admit, and to acknowledge what we need to acknowledge, and to apologize when we need to apologize.

ON TV: #2: Pride diminishes our capacity to say what needs to be said.

ON TV: #3: Pride prevents us from hearing what needs to be heard

ON TV: #4: Pride can't give what needs to be given.

ON TV: Left unchecked, pride diminishes our capacity to love, and it diminishes our capacity to receive love.

ON TV: Pride has the potential to crowd God out.

ON TV: An invitation to follow Jesus is actually an invitation to **unfollow pride**.
