## IT'S MY BUSINESS Making a Comeback – Part 1 of 9

"I One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, with the people crowding around him and listening to the Word of God, 2 he saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. 3He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat." Luke 5:1-3

"4After Jesus finished speaking, he said to Simon, 'Now launch out into deep water and let down the nets for a catch.' 5Simon answered, 'Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets.'" Luke 5:4-5

"6When they had done so; they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break! 7 So, they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full with fish that they began to sink!" Luke 5:6-7

**KEY TAKE-A-WAY:** They caught more in 10 minutes than they had caught in 10 hours when they did it **THE WAY** Jesus said to do it.

#### WHAT SHOULD YOU DO WHEN YOU'VE HAD A BUSINESS SETBACK?

1. I must give Jesus **COMPLETE ACCESS** to my business.

"Jesus got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat." Luke 5:3

### KEY OBSERVATION #1: I must get Jesus in my BOAT

- Your boat is how you make a **LIVING**.
- **2.** I must **ADMIT** that my efforts aren't working.

"4When Jesus had finished speaking, he said to Simon, 'Now launch out into deep water and let down the nets for a catch.' 5 Simon answered, 'Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything!" Luke 5:4-5a

**3.** I must **<u>DO</u>** whatever Jesus tells me to do, even if it seems illogical, you can't afford it, or it appears foolish to others.

"Simon answered, 'Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets." Luke 5:5

# **KEY QUESTION:** What has God told you to do that you still <u>HAVEN'T DONE</u>? • Three Phases: WHEN, WHAT, and WHERE

- **4.** I must **EXPECT** Jesus to turn things around.
- "6 When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break! 7 So, they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink!" Luke 5:6-7

"8 When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, 'Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!' 9 For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken, and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners." Luke 5:8-9

"10 Then Jesus said to Simon, 'don't be afraid; from now on you will catch men!' 11 So, they pulled their boats up on shore, and they left everything and followed Jesus!" Luke 5:10-11

BOTTOM LINE: We must become more interested in the BLESSER, rather than the BLESSING.
