## DO WHAT MAKES YOU HAPPY He Didn't Say That! – Part 3

**ON TV:** "Go into all the world and preach whatever makes people happy."

**ON TV:** "Whoever wants to be my disciple must affirm themselves, avoid uncomfortable and difficult things, and follow their heart."

ON TV: "Ask for whatever you think will make you happy and it will be given to you because God is your Heavenly Sugar Daddy."

**ON TV:** What makes you happy?

ON TV: If only I had, if only I drove, if only I wore, if only I had whatever it is then maybe I would feel better about

**ON TV:** Happiness is more about WHO than WHAT.

**ON TV:** Happiness is always associated with a **WHO** or **TWO**.

ON TV: Happy 'WHAT' always leads to happy 'WHAT ELSE'.

ON TV: If something that gets older and older ultimately diminishes your happiness, you weren't genuinely happy to begin with.

ON TV: "How can they be happy; they don't have anything."

**ON TV:** Parents are never any happier than their **most unhappy child**.

ON TV: At the end of your life if you have regrets, they will be relational regrets; they will not be possessional regrets.

ON TV: When we can't get what we want, we tell ourselves we don't really want it.

**ON TV:** What makes you happy?

**ON TV:** No – thing!

ON TV/OUTLINE: First, happy people have <u>PEACE</u> with <u>THEMSELVES</u>.

ON TV/OUTLINE: Second, happy people are at peace with other <u>PEOPLE</u>.

ON TV/OUTLINE: Third, happy people are at peace with GOD.

**ON TV:** Anything that undermines your peace undermines your happiness.

**ON TV:** And we feel **regret**.

ON TV: Because Christ Followers have discovered that peace with God paves the way to peace with self and it equips us to make peace with others.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Matthew 22:36

**ON TV/OUTLINE:** "Jesus replied, 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your mind." *Matthew 22:37* 

**ON TV/OUTLINE:** "38 This is the first and the greatest command, and the second is like it. 39 And love your neighbor as yourself." Matthew 22:38-39

**ON TV:** We will not stay in unhappy circumstances for very long unless we have a very good reason.

**ON TV:** To **RESIST** God is to actually resist **HAPPINESS**.

**ON TV:** Happiness is more about a WHO than a WHAT.

ON TV: SIN

**ON TV:** Sin separates.

**ON TV:** When sin creeps into a relationship it begins to **erode your happiness**.

**ON TV:** It separates us from God.

ON TV: When you sin against another person, you sin against someone that God loves.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son so that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." John 3:16

ON TV: When you mistreat another person, you are out of sorts with God, not just that other person.

**ON TV:** Sin separates us from other people and sin separates us from God.

**ON TV:** Sin separates you from **YOURSELF**.

**ON TV:** "If I ever I wouldn't be able to live with myself."

ON TV: Sin spearates us from others, from God, and from ourselves by substituting pleasure for fulfillment.

**ON TV:** Sin makes a happy promise that sin can't keep.

ON TV/OUTLINE: "Then, after desire has conceived it gives birth to sin. And sin when it is full grown it gives birth to death."

James 1:15

**ON TV:** What makes you happy?

**ON TV: NO – Thing!** 

**ON TV:** You were born with the **capacity for happiness**, and it is more under **YOUR CONTROL** than you may have ever imagined.
