THE ONE THING Game Over – Part 9 of 10

KEY TRUTH #1 Jesus came to establish a **BRAND-NEW** arrangement for every person to be able to **KNOW** God personally.

"But the chief priests and the Pharisees had given orders that anyone who found out where Jesus was should report it so that they might arrest Him." John 11:57

"12 The next day the great crowd that had come for the Feast heard that Jesus was on His way to Jerusalem."

John 12:12

"He consented and watched for an opportunity to hand Jesus over to them when no crowd was present." Luke 22:6

"15 Then the Pharisees went out and laid plans to trap him in his words. 16 They sent their disciples to him. Teacher,' they said, 'We know that you are a man of integrity and that you teach the way of God in accordance with the truth. You aren't swayed by others because you pay no attention to who they are." Matthew 22:15-16

KEY TRUTH #2: This is his point. Love for God is best illustrated, demonstrated, and proven by our **LOVE** for others.

KEY TRUTH #3: From now on a neighbor is anyone anywhere with a need that **YOU** can meet.

"34 A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have love you, so you must love one another. 35 By this everyone will know that you are my disciples if you love one another." John 13:34-35

KEY OBSERVATION: The old covenant question was: what does the <u>LAW</u> require? The contemporary version of the old covenant question is, what does the <u>BIBLE</u> require? The new covenant question is what does **LOVE** require of **ME**?

KEY TRUTH #4: Every New Testament directive is an opportunity to <u>LIVE OUT</u> this new covenant command.
