# FOUR KEY TRUTHS THAT CAN NEUTRALIZE THE FEAR OF FAILURE

### **KEY TRUTH #1: <u>EVERYBODY</u>** fails in many ways.

"We all stumble in many ways." James 3:2a

"There is no one on earth who always does what is right all the time and never makes a mistake." Ecclesiastes 7:20

## KEY TRUTH #2: No failure is final unless I GIVE UP.

"For even though a righteous man falls seven times, he rises again." Proverbs 24:16

"We must never get tired of doing good because if we don't give up in the struggle, we will get our harvest at the proper time!" Galatians 6:9

### KEY TRUTH #3: Failure is the path to success if I'm HUMBLE & willing to LEARN from it.

"A man who refuses to admit his mistakes will never be successful. But if he confesses and forsakes them, he gets another chance." Proverbs 28:13

- Failure shows us what doesn't WORK.
- Failure develops our **<u>SKILLS</u>**.
- There is no **INNOVATION** without failure.
- Failure makes us a little bit more **<u>HUMBLE</u>** and more loving and gracious.

"These things are warnings written down so that we don't repeat their mistakes. They came before us, but we are just as capable of messing it up as they were!" 1 Corinthians 10:11

**KEY TRUTH #4:** No matter what happens, God's promises to use it for **GOOD** in my life.

"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who've been called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28

"Look at all the ways in which your distress has goaded you closer to God! You're more alive, more concerned, more sensitive, more reverent, more human, more passionate, more responsible. Looked at from any angle, you've come out of this with purity of heart." 2 Corinthians 7:11

# FOUR ACTION STEPS TO TAKE TO NEUTRALIZE THE FEAR OF FAILURE

### ACTION STEP #1: Refuse to <u>COMPARE</u> myself to others.

"You should judge your own actions but never compare yourself with others. Then you can be proud for doing your best without comparing yourself to anyone else." Galatians 6:4

"We don't dare to compare or classify ourselves as some do. For when they measure themselves by one another and compare themselves with one another, they are unwise, acting foolish." 2 Corinthians 10:12

### ACTION STEP #2: <u>**REDEFINE</u>** the meaning of failure.</u>

| Failure is NOT:               | Real Failure is:               |
|-------------------------------|--------------------------------|
| -missing a goal.              | -not <u>HAVING</u> a goal      |
| -being unable to do something | -being <u>UNWILLING</u> to try |

"Without faith it is impossible to please God." Hebrews 11:6

"According to your faith it will be done to you." Matthew 9:29

### ACTION STEP #3: <u>REFOCUS</u> on God's love for me and others.

"Wherever God's love is, there is no fear, because God's perfect love drives out all fear." 1 John 4:18

"7 Love never stops being patient. Love never stops believing. Love is always hopeful. Love never gives up. 8 Love never fails!" 1 Corinthians 13:7-8a

## ACTION STEP #4: <u>**REPLACE</u>** my fear with faith in Jesus.</u>

"I have the strength to face all conditions by the power that Christ gives me." Philippians 4:13
