

THE VALUE OF ONE

Who's Your One? – Part 3 of 5

"Jesus looked at His disciples, and He said, 'Follow Me and I'm going to make you fishers of men.'"
Matthew 4:19

KEY OBSERVATION #1: The message of Christianity is something that is communicated person to person...to your **ONE**.

"13 When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, 'Who do people say the Son of Man is?' 14 They replied, 'Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets.' 15 'But what about you?' he asked. 'Who do you say I am?' 16 Simon Peter answered, 'You are the Christ the Son of the living God.' 17 Jesus replied, 'Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by man, but by my Father in heaven. 18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock, I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.'"
Matthew 16:13-18

KEY QUESTION: What's the **RELATIONSHIP** between my individual responsibility to fish and Jesus building his church no matter what?

WHAT HAVE WE LEARNED?

#2: Being in a community of committed Christ Followers **BREAKS DOWN** barriers to unbelief.

#3: When the church is strategic around **OFFICIAL JESUS BUSINESS**, Jesus shows up in its midst.

#4: The **CHURCH** is the most powerful, persuasive organization on earth.
