

What are you focused on?

1) Focus upon the coming grace, the salvation of God.

1 Peter 1:13 Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest *your* hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; (NKJ)

Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatever things are **true**, whatever things *are noble*, whatever things *are just*, whatever things *are pure*, whatever things *are lovely*, whatever things *are of good report*, if *there is* any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. (NKJ)

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. ⁴ For the weapons of our warfare *are* not ^[a]carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, ⁵ casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, (NKJ)

2) Focus upon obedience.

1 Peter 1:14 As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. (NIV)

Matthew 12:50 For whoever does the will of My Father in heaven is My brother and sister and mother.” (NKJ)

3) Focus upon holiness.

1 Peter 1:15-16 but as He who called you *is* holy, you also be holy in all *your* conduct, ¹⁶ because it is written, “Be holy, for I am holy.” (NKJ)

Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (NKJ)
