Job Answers His Critics

1) Job's Sarcastic Rebuke.

Job 12:1-3 Then Job answered and said: ² "No doubt you *are* the people, And wisdom will die with you! ³ But I have ^[a] understanding as well as you; I *am* not inferior to you. Indeed, who does not *know* such things as these? (NKJ)

2) Misjudged by Men Yet Loved by God.

Job 12:4-6 Yet my friends laugh at me, for I call on God and expect an answer. I am a just and blameless man, yet they laugh at me. ⁵ People who are at ease mock those in trouble. They give a push to people who are stumbling. ⁶ But robbers are left in peace, and those who provoke God live in safety, though God keeps them in his power. (NLT)

3) Wisdom Shown in Creation.

Job 12:7-10 "But now ask the beasts, and they will teach you; And the birds of the air, and they will tell you; ⁸ Or speak to the earth, and it will teach you; And the fish of the sea will explain to you. ⁹ Who among all these does not know That the hand of the Lord has done this, ¹⁰ In whose hand *is* the ^[a] life of every living thing, And the breath of ^[b] all mankind? (NKJ)

Isaiah 64:8 But now, O Lord, You *are* our Father; We *are* the clay, and You our potter; And all we *are* the work of Your hand. (NKJ)

The metaphor of God's hand usually conveys the image of strength or power.

1 Chronicles 29:12 Both riches and honor *come* from You, And You reign over all. In Your hand *is* power and might; In Your hand *it* is to make great And to give strength to all. (NKJ)

4) Wisdom Belongs to God and Is Learned Over Time.

Job 12:11-12 Does not the ear test words And the ^[a]mouth taste its food? ¹² Wisdom *is* with aged men, And with ^[b]length of days, understanding. (NKJ)

James 1:5 If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. (NLT)

"God Holds Wisdom and Power"

1) God's Wisdom and Power Are Supreme.

Job 12:13 "With Him are wisdom and strength, He has counsel and understanding. (NKJ)

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (NKJ)

2) God Overrules Human Plans.

Job 12:14-15 If He breaks *a thing* down, it cannot be rebuilt; *If* He imprisons a man, there can be no release. ¹⁵ If He withholds the waters, they dry up; *If* He sends them out, they overwhelm the earth. (NKJ)

3) God Unmasks Human Leaders.

Job 12:16-22 To him belong strength and insight; both deceived and deceiver are his. ¹⁷ He leads rulers away stripped and makes fools of judges. ¹⁸ He takes off the shackles put on by kings and ties a loincloth^[a] around their waist. ¹⁹ He leads priests away stripped and overthrows officials long established. ²⁰ He silences the lips of trusted advisers and takes away the discernment of elders. ²¹ He pours contempt on nobles and disarms the mighty. ²² He reveals the deep things of darkness and brings utter darkness into the light. (NIV)

4) God Rules Over Nations and History.

Job 12:23-25 He makes nations great, and destroys them; He ^[a]enlarges nations, and guides them. ²⁴ He takes away the ^[b]understanding of the chiefs of the people of the earth, And makes them wander in a pathless wilderness. ²⁵They grope in the dark without light, And He makes them stagger like a drunken *man. (NKJ)*
