Hebrews3:17-19 Nkjv

17 Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness? 18 And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey? 19 So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

Unbelief took their ability to enter God's rest away from them.

Their actions revealed their unbelief.

Walking with God reveals your faith or lack of faith and understanding or lack of

understanding in our actions.

The Promise of Rest

4 Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it. 2 For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it

If you've heard the "good news", the gospel Is it mixed with faith?

Hebrews 4:3-10

3 For we who have believed do enter that rest, as He has said:

"So I swore in My wrath,

'They shall not enter My rest,' "

although the works were finished from the foundation of the world. 4 For He has spoken

in a certain place of the seventh day in this way: "And God rested on the seventh day

from all His works"; 5 and again in this place: "They shall not enter My rest."

6 Since therefore it remains that some must enter it, and those to whom it was first preached

did not enter because of disobedience, 7 again He designates a certain day, saying in David,

"Today," after such a long time, as it has been said:

"Today, if you will hear His voice,

Do not harden your hearts."

8 For if Joshua had given them rest, then He would not afterward have spoken of another day.

9 There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. 10 For he who has entered His rest has two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow,

and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

himself also ceased from his works as God did from His.

Joshua is equivalent to saying Jesus in that they both mean Yeshua or yehoshua

When Joshua & the children of Israel entered into the promised land they were being led by

Joshua as a successor to Moses and to observe the law.

Now, the people of God in verse 9 have the "good news mixed with faith" to enter His rest
