

How's your Faith. Part 2

2) Victory and Deliverance.

Exodus 14:13-15 And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. ¹⁴The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace." ¹⁵And the Lord said to Moses, "Why do you cry to Me? Tell the children of Israel to go forward. (NKJ)

1) God demands that we arise and go forth: that we be diligent, steadfast, and unmovable in life.

1 Corinthians 4:2 Now, a person who is put in charge as a manager must be faithful. (NLT)

2) God demands passion in life.

John 4:35 Do you not say, 'There are still four months and *then* comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! (NKJ)

3) God's purpose for dividing the Red Sea.

Exodus 14:16-18 But lift up your rod, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it. And the children of Israel shall go on dry *ground* through the midst of the sea. ¹⁷And I indeed will harden the hearts of the Egyptians, and they shall follow them. So I will gain honor over Pharaoh and over all his army, his chariots, and his horsemen. ¹⁸Then the Egyptians shall know that I *am* the Lord, when I have gained honor for Myself over Pharaoh, his chariots, and his horsemen." (NKJ)

Deuteronomy 4:39 "So remember this and keep it firmly in mind: The Lord is God both in heaven and on earth, and there is no other. (NLT)

4) The mighty deliverance of God.

Exodus 14:19-20 And the Angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them; and the pillar of cloud went from before them and stood behind them. ²⁰So it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel. Thus it was a cloud and darkness *to the one*, and it gave light by night *to the other*, so that the one did not come near the other all that night. (NKJ)

Psalms 91:11 For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways. (NKJ)

Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation? (NKJ)

Exodus 14:21-22 Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the Lord caused the sea to go *back* by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea into dry *land*, and the waters were divided. ²²So the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea on the dry *ground*, and the waters *were* a wall to them on their right hand and on their left. (NKJ)

Jeremiah 32:27 "Behold, I *am* the Lord, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me? (NKJ)

God's presence and control delivered His people.

Exodus 14:23-26 And the Egyptians pursued and went after them into the midst of the sea, all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen. ²⁴ Now it came to pass, in the morning watch, that the Lord looked down upon the army of the Egyptians through the pillar of fire and cloud, and He ^[a]troubled the army of the Egyptians. ²⁵ And He ^[b]took off their chariot wheels, so that they drove them with difficulty; and the Egyptians said, "Let us flee from the face of Israel, for the Lord fights for them against the Egyptians." ²⁶ Then the Lord said to Moses, "Stretch out your hand over the sea, that the waters may come back upon the Egyptians, on their chariots, and on their horsemen." (NKJ)

Exodus 14:27-28 And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and when the morning appeared, the sea returned to its full depth, while the Egyptians were fleeing into it. So the Lord overthrew^[a] the Egyptians in the midst of the sea. ²⁸ Then the waters returned and covered the chariots, the horsemen, *and* all the army of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them. Not so much as one of them remained. (NKJ)

Psalms 106:8-11 Nevertheless He saved them for His name's sake, That He might make His mighty power known. ⁹ He rebuked the Red Sea also, and it dried up; So He led them through the depths, As through the wilderness. ¹⁰ He saved them from the hand of him who hated *them*, And redeemed them from the hand of the enemy.

¹¹ The waters covered their enemies; There was not one of them left. (NKJ)

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*. (NKJ)

5) The LORD's salvation of His people.

Exodus 14:29-31 But the children of Israel had walked on dry *land* in the midst of the sea, and the waters *were* a wall to them on their right hand and on their left. ³⁰ So the Lord saved^[a] Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians dead on the seashore. ³¹ Thus Israel saw the great ^[b]work which the Lord had done in Egypt; so the people feared the Lord, and believed the Lord and His servant Moses. (NKJ)

Exodus 14:31 Thus Israel saw the great work which the Lord had done in Egypt; so the people feared the Lord, and believed the Lord and His servant Moses. NKJ)

Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; (NKJ)
