# **Choosing Satisfaction in God Over the World**

## 1) Description of the Wicked.

**Psalms 17:10-12** They have closed up their fat *hearts;* With their mouths they speak proudly. <sup>11</sup> They have now surrounded us in our steps; They have set their eyes, crouching down to the earth, <sup>12</sup> As a lion is eager to tear his prey, And like a young lion lurking in secret places. (NKJ)

#### 2) The Plea for Protection.

**Psalms 17:13** Arise, O Lord, Confront him, cast him down; Deliver my life from the wicked with Your sword, (NKJ)

## 3) The Portion of the Worldly.

**Psalms 17:14** With Your hand from men, O Lord, From men of the world *who have* their portion in *this* life, And whose belly You fill with Your hidden treasure. They are satisfied with children, And leave the rest of their *possession* for their babes. (NKJ)

# 4) The Hope of the Righteous.

**Psalms 17:15** As for me, I will see Your face in righteousness; I shall be satisfied when I awake in Your likeness. (NKJ)

**Psalm 16:11** You will show me the path of life; In Your presence *is* fullness of joy; At Your right hand *are* pleasures forevermore. (NKJ)

## **Chapter 18 "The God Who Hears and Delivers"**

#### 1) A Declaration of Love and Trust.

**Psalms 18:1-2** I will love You, O Lord, my strength. <sup>2</sup>The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my <sup>[a]</sup>strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the <sup>[b]</sup>horn of my salvation, my stronghold. (NKJ)

#### 2) A Commitment to Call.

**Psalms 18:3** I will call upon the Lord, *who is worthy* to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies. (NKJ)

## 3) A Description of Despair.

**Psalms 18:4-5** The pangs of death surrounded me, And the floods of <sup>[a]</sup>ungodliness made me afraid. <sup>5</sup> The sorrows of Sheol surrounded me; The snares of death confronted me. (NKJ)

## 4) A Cry That Reaches Heaven.

**Psalms 18:6** In my distress I called upon the Lord, And cried out to my God; He heard my voice from His temple, And my cry came before Him, *even* to His ears. (NKJ)
