

The World or God, Your Choice

Is it too late?—have we missed God’s instruction?—do we live according to 1 Corinthians 7:23, “You were bought with a price; do not become slaves of men.” Are we already slaves to the ways of the world? On Sunday do we fit attending a church service in around sports and shopping? And the other days of the week, do we constantly strive to attain worldly wants?

If you could work a few more hours and then have enough money for that fancy car—but working more hours would mean you missed every game of your child’s sports season, would you choose to strive for the fancy car or settle for a reliable, but cheaper car so that you could watch and encourage your child at all the games? If you had the chance to be nominated to a position on a powerful, state-wide health policy development committee--but first you had to renounce your stand against abortion--would you choose the position of power or remain true to your beliefs against abortion? If you see an opportunity to sneak a few items past the eyes of the watchful, self-checkout clerk, would you take advantage of that potential dishonest moment? Sadly, many people are so focused achieving worldly goals, power, and worldly prestige that they will compromise Biblical teachings and do anything to get ahead—ahead by the world’s standards.

Jesus told us in Matthew 6:33, “But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness.” KJV The ways and rewards of this world are quickly forgotten and trampled on by the next worldly, wanna-be powerful person. Remember what Jeremiah 32:19 says about God, “You are great in counsel and mighty in work, for your eyes are open to all the ways of the sons of men, to give everyone according to his ways and according to the fruit of his doings.” NKJV Do you choose to be “slaves of men” or live to seek the kingdom of God?
