Big Idea: Welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you.

We are to welcome one another:

I. Because Christ welcomed us (Rom. 15:7; 14:1-4)

Romans Road:

- **Rom. 3:23** - *For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.*
- **Rom. 6:23** - *For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.*
- **Rom. 5:8** - *But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.*
- **Rom. 10:9** - *If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.*

II. Like Christ welcomed us (Rom. 14-15:9)

- A. Impartially (Rom. 15:8-9; 14:4-6)
- B. Selflessly (Rom. 15:1-3a)
- C. Sacrificially (Rom. 15:3; 14:15)

III. For God's glory through our unity (Rom. 15:5-7)
