## HOW DOES GOD JUSTIFY THE UNGODLY?

- 1. The ungodly are justified by faith, not works (4:1-8).
  - a. Faith excludes boasting before God (vv. 1-3).
  - b. Faith is helplessness reaching out in total dependence upon God (vv. 4-5).
  - c. Justification is God declaring the ungodly righteous and not counting their sins against them (vv. 6-8).
- 2. The ungodly are justified by faith, not rituals (4:9-12).
  - a. Justification has always been by faith through grace (vv. 9-10).
  - b. Circumcision was a sign of faith, not a substitute for it (vv. 11-12).
- 3. The ungodly are justified by faith, not law (4:13-17).
