Main Idea: We can know the Father through the Son.

"It is completely incomprehensible to us how God can reveal himself and to some extent make himself known in created beings: eternity in time, immensity in space, infinity in the finite, immutability in change, being in becoming, the all as it were, in that which is nothing." (Bavinck)

"What it means is that the beloved Son, the incarnate Word (1:14), himself God while being at the Father's side - just as in v. 1 the Word was simultaneously God and with God - has broken the barrier that made it impossible for human beings to see God, and has made him known." (Carson, 134)
