BIG IDEA: Jesus supremely satisfies authentic worshipers.

I. We are all worshippers (John 4:1-20)

- a. We are created to worship God (Genesis 1:27-28; 2:15-17; John 4:20)
- b. We are unable to worship God in our Sin (Genesis 3:22-24; John 4:22; 3:19-20; Psalm 24:3-4; Romans 3:9-12; 1 John 1:8)
- c. We worship counterfeit gods that cannot satisfy (John 4:13-18; Romans 1:21-23; 7:21-23)

II. Jesus restores fallen worshipers (John 4:21-42; Romans 7:24-25a)

- a. Jesus pursues us in our sin (John 4:4, 22-26; 3:16-17)
- b. Jesus restores us as authentic worshippers (John 4:24-25; Jeremiah 31:33-34; 1 John 1:9)
- c. Jesus supremely satisfies (John 4:28-42; 6:35; Matthew 5:6)
