V. Bear Burdens by Gently and Cautiously Restoring Believers Overtaken by Sin

Galatians 6:1 | Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted.

VI. Bear Burdens In a Way That Fulfills the Law of Christ

Galatians 6:2 | Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

VII. Bear Burdens Humbly Not Self-Deceptively

Galatians 6:3 | For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

VIII. Bear Burdens by Rightly Directing Your Boast

Galatians 6:4 | But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbor.

IX. Be Ready to Bear "Your Own" Burden in Christ On the Last Day

Galatians 6:5 | For each will have to bear his own load.
