Big Idea: Clarify the Gospel

- I. Gospel ≠ Christ + Works (vv. 1-12, 28)
 - 1. Misplaced Works

Legalism:

(in biblical context) - the understanding that salvation is in Christ but made complete by keeping the Mosaic law.

(in today's context) - seeking to earn or merit salvation by rule-keeping.

- 2. The Sufficiency of Christ
- II. Gospel = Christ Idolatry (vv. 19-29)
 - 1. Misplaced Worship

Syncretism: the fusion of religions or religious practices.

- 2. The Standard of Christ
- III. Gospel = Old Testament + New Testament (vv. 13-18, 32-35)
 - 1. Misplaced Reading
 - 2. The Scripture of Christ
