Genesis 25:23 | “And the LORD said to her, “Two nations are in your womb, and two peoples from within you shall be divided; the one shall be stronger than the other, the older shall serve the younger.”

BIG IDEA: God accomplishes His plan through undeserving sinners.

I. God's plan prevails (27:1-29)

II. Our sin requires true repentance (27:30-46)

- a. Godly grief leads to repentance (27:30-33)

Hebrews 11:20 | “By faith Isaac invoked future blessings on Jacob and Esau.”

- b. Worldly grief leads to ruin (27:34-40)

Hebrews 12:16-17 | “16 that no one is sexually immoral or unholy like Esau, who sold his birthright for a single meal. 17 For you know that afterward, when he desired to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no chance to repent, though he sought it with tears.”

- c. All sin has consequences (27:41-46)
