Testimony

Big Idea: Stand amazed at the incredible work of Christ on behalf of the world.

1) In Adam all die

- a) **We are in sin (12, 19)**
- b) **We are condemned (16, 18)**
- c) **We are dead (12, 14, 15, 17)**

2) In Christ all live

- a) **We are righteous (17, 19)**
- b) **We are justified (16, 18)**
- c) **We are alive (17, 18, 21)**

Application of understanding Jesus is the greater and better Adam:

- 1) We are now motivated and capable to walk in newness of life.
- 2) We now have a correct worldview.
- 3) We now desire to tell everyone about Jesus.
