Big Idea: Disciples are so shaped by the gospel that we walk together in harmony despite our differences.

I. Remember from where you've been called

Ephesians 4:1-2a | 1 | therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, 2 with all humility

II. Remember from where your brother or sister has been called

Ephesians 4:2b | 2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love,

III. Remember to what we have been called.

Ephesians 4:3-6 | 3 eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. 4 There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6 one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.
