Trust Our Sovereign God

Big Idea: We must entrust ourselves to our sovereign God...

I. When enemies oppose us (1-5)

- a. Remember the truth
 - i. They are opposed to Christ in us (John 3:19-20; John 15:20-21; Ephesians 2:1-2; 6:12)
 - ii. They will stand before God in judgment (Acts 23:5)
 - iii. They cannot separate us from the love of God (Romans 8:35-39)
 - iv. They cannot act outside of God's perfect plan (Acts 25:4-5; Genesis 50:20; Isaiah 46:8-10)
- b. Stay on mission
 - i. Do what we know to do
 - 1. Rely upon our God-given authorities (Romans 13:3-4)
 - 2. If we can, remove ourselves from the threat (Acts 23:17-35)
 - ii. Love our enemies
 - 1. Pray for our enemies (Matthew 5:43-45)
 - 2. Serve our enemies (Romans 12:14-21)
 - 3. Share the gospel with our enemies (Acts 22:1-21)

II. As authorities rule over us (6-12)

- a. Remember the truth
 - iii. They are God's gift for promoting good and punishing evil (Romans 13:1-7; Acts 23:5)
 - iv. They are fallen people who sin (Romans 3:23)
 - v. They are God's servants who will answer to him in the final judgment (Romans 13:4; Psalm 2:10-12)
 - vi. They cannot rule outside of God's perfect plan (Acts 25:9-12; Proverbs 21:1; Isaiah 46:8-10)
- b. Stay on mission
 - i. Do what we know to do
 - 1. Submit to authority that does not lead to sin (Romans 13:1-7)
 - 2. Submit to God rather than authority that would lead to sin (Acts 5:29)
 - ii. Love our authorities
 - 1. Pray for our authorities (1 Timothy 2:1-4)
 - 2. Respect their position (Romans 13:1-7)
 - 3. Share the gospel with our authorities (Matthew 10:16-20)

III. When circumstances are beyond us (13-27)

- a. Remember the truth
 - i. God is with us (Matthew 28:20; Acts 23:11)
 - ii. God is faithful (Matthew 6:33; 1 Thessalonians 5:24)
 - iii. We have brothers and sisters who love us (John 13:34-35; Ephesians 6:18-20)
 - iv. Our circumstances are part of God's perfect plan (Isaiah 46:8-10; Romans 8:28-29)
- b. Stay on Mission
 - i. Do what we know to do
 - 1. Abide in Christ (John 8:31-32; 15:5)
 - 2. Seek help from God and others (James 5:13-14; Romans 12:13)
 - ii. Leverage our circumstances for the gospel
 - 1. Pray for God to produce hope within us (Romans 5:3-5)
 - 2. Boast in our weaknesses (2 Corinthians 12:9-10)
 - 3. Share the gospel with the people God brings into our lives (1 Peter 3:14-15).
