BIG IDEA: The grace of God has been revealed through Jesus Christ our savior.

I. The grace of God appeared (2:11a)

Titus 2:11a | “For the grace of God has appeared,”

A. Grace is God’s unmerited favor for undeserving sinners.

“For the grace of God”

Titus 3:5 | “he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit,”

“Grace is not something God himself gives us; it is the way he gives us himself.”

B. The grace of God appeared in the incarnation of Christ.

“has appeared,”

God’s grace suddenly shines into our moral darkness like the rising of the sun.

John 1:14 | “And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.”

II. The grace of God saves (2:11b)

Titus 2:11b | “bringing salvation for all people,”

A. Salvation is God rescuing sinners from the sin, death, and judgment that they deserve.

“bringing salvation”

1 Timothy 1:15 | “The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost.”

B. The grace of God brought salvation for all people without distinction.
“for all people,”

1 Timothy 4:10 | “For to this end we toil and strive, because we have our hope set on the living God, who is the Savior of all people, especially of those who believe.”
