Big Idea

True unity is not something believers pursue or manufacture but a reflection of our common union with Christ.

Union with Christ: Spiritual connection with Christ and the numerous benefits believers receive in salvation through relationship with Christ.

True Unity is...

- I. Supernatural
 - a. Results from the gospel (20-21)
 - b. Reflects God's character (21-23)

II. Observable

a. Authenticates the gospel (21, 23)

What binds us together is not common education, common race, common income levels, common politics, common ancestry, common accents, common jobs, or anything else of that sort...
