# Big Idea: Rejoice! Jesus triumphs against the powers of this world.

#### I. Jesus conquers dark, spiritual forces. (vv. 11-17)

Reflect

- Do we recognize the spiritual realm?
- Do we believe Jesus acts supernaturally in this world?
- Are you "invoking" Jesus or following Jesus?

### II. Jesus redeems us from persisting idols. (vv. 18-20)

Reflect

• What competes for Jesus's kingship in our lives?

Matthew 11:28-30 | "28 Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

### III. Jesus overcomes those who oppose and rage against His church. (vv. 21-41)

Reflect

- Will we continue to trust God's goodness?
- When opposed, do we balance boldness with wisdom?
