Hebrews 11:21 | By faith Jacob, when dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, bowing in worship over the head of his staff.

Psalm 78:67-68 | 67 He rejected the tent of Joseph; he did not choose the tribe of Ephraim, 68 but he chose the tribe of Judah, Mount Zion, which he loves.

III. The Focus of Our Trust

a. The Lion of Judah (49:8-12)

Revelation 5:1-5 | 1 Then I saw in the right hand of him who was seated on the throne a scroll written within and on the back, sealed with seven seals. 2 And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and break its seals?" 3 And no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll or to look into it, 4 and I began to weep loudly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it. 5 And one of the elders said to me, "Weep no more; behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has conquered, so that he can open the scroll and its seven seals."

b. The Eternal Son (48:15-16)

Revelation 5:5-6 | ... 5 And one of the elders said to me, "Weep no more; behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has conquered, so that he can open the scroll and its seven seals." <u>6 And between the throne and the four living creatures and among the elders I saw a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain,</u>
