5 Day Devotional Guide

The Only Way

Day 1: The Authenticity of Christ

Scripture: Luke 23:26-43

Devotional: Jesus' journey to the cross reveals His authentic love and unwavering commitment to God's plan. As He carried His cross, Jesus demonstrated the reality of His teachings about self-denial and wholehearted devotion. The criminal who recognized Jesus' innocence and kingship shows us the power of authentic faith. Today, reflect on areas of your life where you might be holding back from fully following Christ. Day 2: The Way, the Truth, and the Life

Scripture: John 14:1-14

Day 3: From Death to Life

Scripture: Luke 24:1-12

The women who first witnessed the empty tomb remind us that God often works through the unexpected and marginalized. Their faith and courage in the face of doubt inspire us. Day 4: The Call to Wholehearted Devotion

Reading: Luke 9:23-27

Devotional: Jesus' call to deny ourselves and take up our cross daily is a radical invitation to a transformed life. This isn't about self-improvement or casual spirituality; it's about complete surrender to Christ's lordship. Reflect on areas where you might be trying to follow Jesus halfway. What would it look like to fully commit those areas to Him? Remember, the cost of following Christ is high, but the reward of knowing and serving Him is immeasurably greater.

Day 5: Proclaiming the Risen Lord

Reading: Acts 4:1-12

Devotional: Peter's bold proclamation before the Sanhedrin shows the transformative power of encountering the risen Christ. The once-fearful disciple now confidently declares that salvation is found in no one else but Jesus. This exclusive claim flows from a heart overwhelmed by God's love and grace. As you reflect on your own journey with Christ, how has He changed your life? How can you, like Peter, courageously share the hope you have in Jesus, even in the face of opposition or skepticism?
