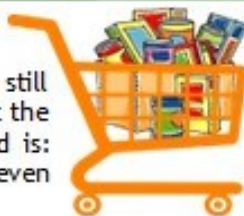
For anyone interested in participating in a Bell Choir, practice will be held every Tuesday at 6:30PM in the music room. Please contact Les Ronning if you are interested.
