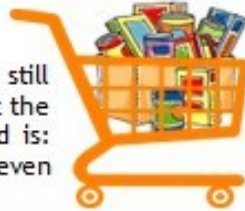
For anyone interested in participating in a Bell Choir, practice will be held every Tuesday at 6:30PM in the music room. Please contact Les Ronning if you are interested.

If you are wanting a shirt and missed the deadline there are various sizes in the office. If you want one you can stop by the office during office hours and get yours.



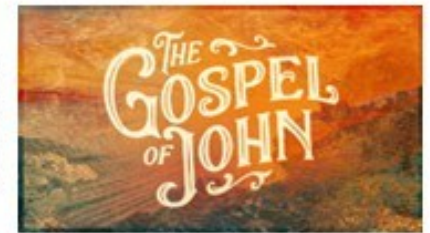
