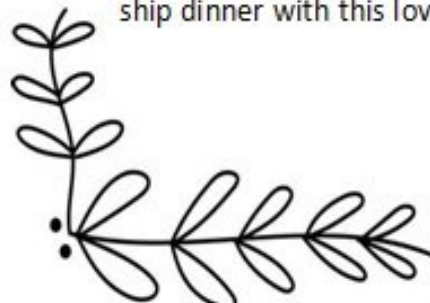
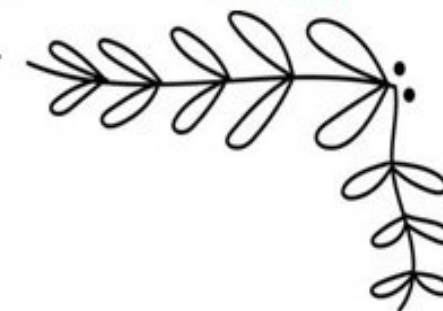
- The next Session Meeting for all active Elders of the church will be held on Tuesday, June 9th 6PM in the Sunday School room.
