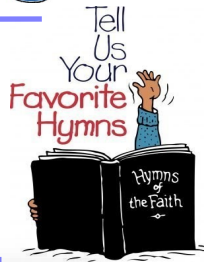
Announcements

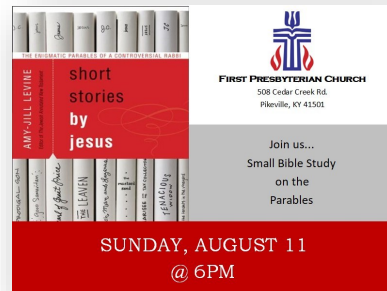
