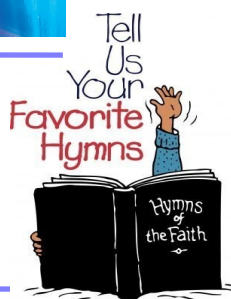
The Book Study continues tonight at 6PM in the conference room. Please join us!
