- Online giving is available! Just scan the QR code below to give using your credit/debit card.

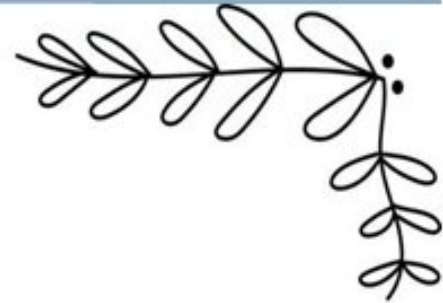


School's out for Summer!

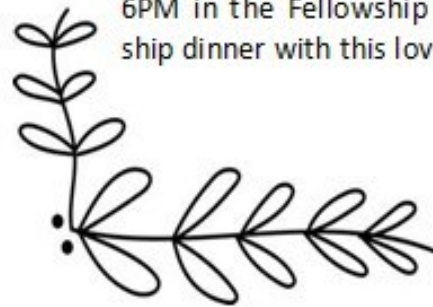
