When God says that He is j, it is not the same as man's
jealousy, but He does have the same thing in mind.

3"Thus says the LORD: 'I will return to Zion, And dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be called the City of Truth, The Mountain of the LORD of hosts, The Holy Mountain.'

Isaiah 2:1-2

1The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.
