## What on Earth is Heaven? Class #3:

Rapture to Heaven—or Resurrected into New Creation?

## **KEY QUESTIONS concerning Heaven:**

What *is eternal life* with God? Where, who and what *are we* throughout eternity, and how/when/why does all this come about? How will we spend eternity—and who will we be? We continue to answer these key questions by asking again:

As Christians, what exactly is our "*blessed hope*" in Christ? Of two major ideas, which does the **Bible** say *it is*:

- 1. Escape the coming time of tribulation by the [secret] **rapture** of all the living righteous away from earth *into heaven* to join those who have already died in Christ, as Jewish evangelist offer those left last hope, *or*:
- 2. The final vindication of all who are "*asleep in the LORD*" by their **resurrection from the dead**, joining with Christ's people still alive at Jesus' return, and entering into the *new* (restored) *creation* of God, here *on earth*, on "*the day of the LORD*"—the day of Christ return?

Historical sketch of modern **Dispensationalism** and Its Concept of **Rapture**:

- John Nelson Darby and Plymouth Brethren (1840's), developed:
- **Dispensationalism**: Israel-centric, prophetic 'literalism' (later adopted by Fundamentalism) in place of Christocentric prophetic interpretation.
- Azusa Street Mission Revival (birth of modern Pentecostalism)
- Cyrus Scofield (1843-1921) and the Scofield Study Bible (1909)
- Popularized and mainstreamed by Hal Lindsay: *Late, Great Planet Earth*; then Tim LaHaye's fictionalized novels: *Left Behind*!

In the **New Testament**, **what** exactly is the reward or vindication/rescue of the Righteous (and exactly **when** is it coming)?

The Three Stages of the Biblical doctrine of "The Resurrection from the Dead":

- 1. **PAST**: Jesus (is "the firstfruits" of *the resurrected from the dead*): Romans 1:2-4; 6:8-10; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, 20-22; Isaiah 53:11; Revelation 1:5. We *have been* JUSTIFIED by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- PRESENT: Our *current status* with God "*in Christ*": 2 Corinthians 5:17; Romans 6:4,11; Ephesians 2:5-6 (see 1:13-14); Colossians 1:12-14; Revelation 5:9-10. We *are being* SANCTIFIED by the presence of God the Spirit in us even now, as we await:
- FUTURE: The final, visible, physical resurrection from the dead of all "*in Christ*" on the great "*Day of the LORD*": Isaiah 25:9; Malachi 4:1-3; Matthew 7:22; 25:31-34; Acts 17:31-32; Romans 2:5; 1 Corinthians 15:22-24; 2 Timothy 1:9-10; 2 Timothy 4:8; 2 Peter 3:7; Jude 6, 21. On that day, we will be GLORIFIED with Christ (Philippians 3:20-21; 2 Thessalonians 1:10; 1 Corinthians 3:13; Titus 2:13).

So, in terms of the Kingdom of God, as Christ-followers, we live:

- "even now" in our acceptance before God into His Kingdom *in Christ*, by the indwelling of His Spirit *in us* (Ephesians 1:13-14; 2:4-6; Romans 8:10-11; Colossians 1:12-14; Galatians 1:3-4).
- "**not yet**" in the full presence of God's life *with us* and healing of us at the "restoration of all things" (Matthew 19:28; Acts 3:20-21; Rev 21:1-6).
